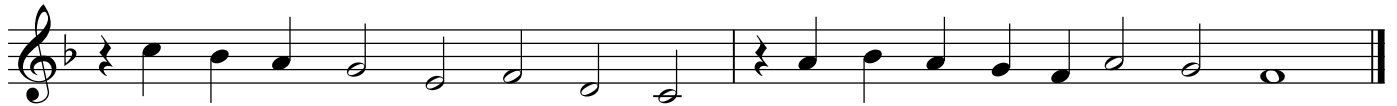


# The Day Is Drawing Near, But When?
